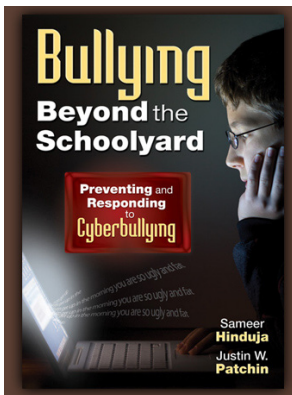

Dr. Justin Patchin, Co-Director of the Cyberbullying Research Center is an Associate Professor of Criminal Justice in the Department of Political Science at the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire. He has presented on various topics relating to juvenile justice, school violence, policy and program evaluation, and adolescent internet use and misuse at academic conferences and training seminars across the United States. His most recent book *Bullying Beyond the Schoolyard: Preventing and Responding to Cyberbullying*, examines the ways adolescents use technology to cause harm to their peers (and what adults can do about it).
